Demonstrably material

- Overall frame for the scheme:
 - Obligated parties must focus on savings, that would not have been achieved at this time, without the involvement of the parties.
 - The activities of the obligated parties must provide an advantage for the target consumers and the main part of the total costs of the scheme must accrue to the target consumers (directly or indirectly).
- Specific measures:
 - Obligated parties must document prior involvement through an agreement of collaboration between the end user and the obligated party before the EE measure is initiated. Obligated parties cannot report savings that are carried out without their involvement.
 - Subsidy is not allowed, if the subsidy brings the payback time of the EE measure below 1 year.

Additionality

- **Approach → focus on overall frame, not on individual cases**
- **Specific measures:**
 - **2009: Politically defined target was increased by ca. 15 %**
 - **Measures with a high degree of natural replacement are excluded (e.g. household appliances, light bulbs)**
 - **Degree of natural replacement and “market average” is factored in when setting the specific values for deemed savings.**
 - **For new constructions and maintenance, only solutions exceeding minimum requirements, or market standards, are eligible.**
