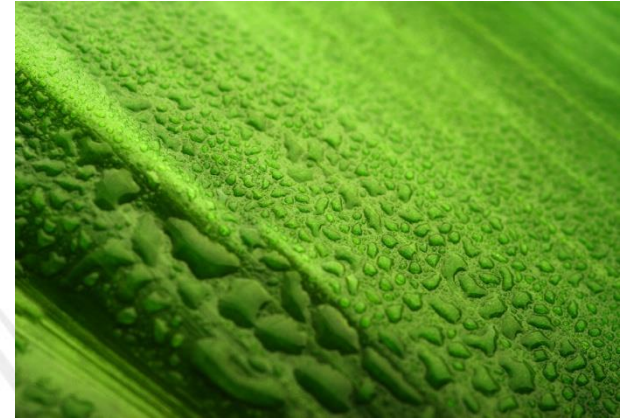

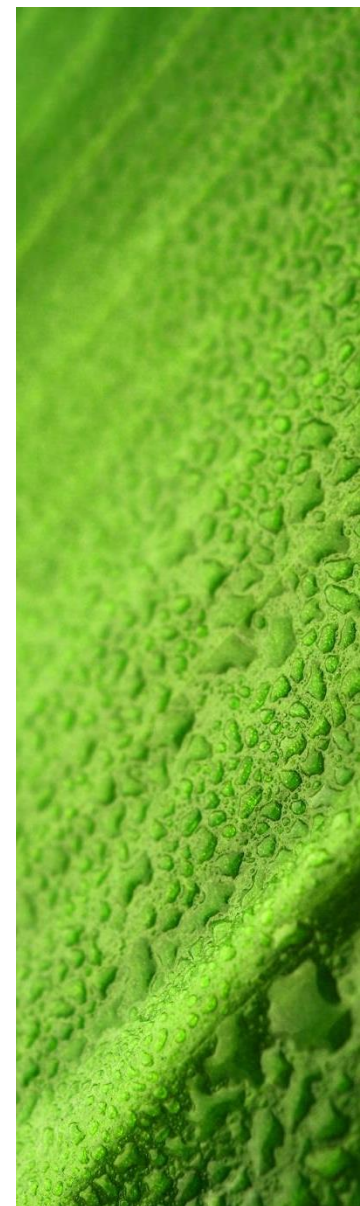


Massive potential in energy efficiency in Poland

- Aging infrastructure





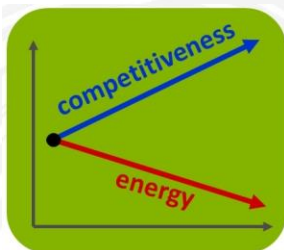
