ADEME's "help in decision making" system



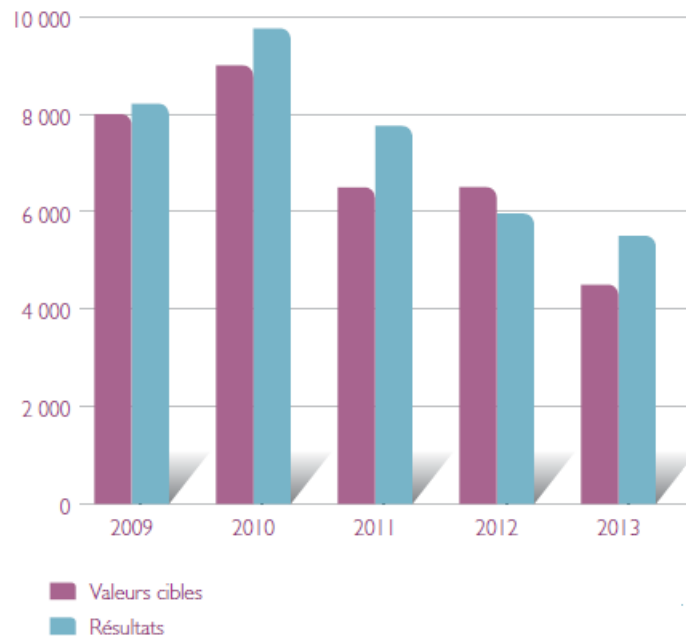
- The ADEME's " Help in decision making " system funds the carrying out of studies on energy efficiency, or on other environmental issues :
 - In industry
 - In agriculture
 - In the tertiary sector
- This scheme includes :
 - Audits or energy diagnostics as they have not been made obligatory by regulations for smes
 - Implementation of energy management systems.

ADEME's "help in decision making" system



- Some key figures :

Indicateur 09-08 Nombre annuel d'aides à la décision



- 5 500 studies have benefited from this scheme in 2013 :

- 36% light audits
- 37% in-depth audits
- 27% feasibility studies in link with a project

- Adressed issues in 2013 :

- Energy efficiency 71%
- Cross-cutting issues 16%
- Waste 11%
- Air quality 2%

In 2013 :

- High implementation rates of at least one recommended measures are observed : around 80%
- Dissemination through 55 best practices factsheets

ADEME's funding system

- This scheme aims at supporting EE investments :
 - Purchase of energy saving equipment
 - Making changes to processes
- Demonstration or example operations
- Annual budget of 500 000 €

The “Green loans” system



- This scheme is dedicated to the industry sector
- It allows smes to benefit from low interest loans and loan guarantees :
 - For investment to increase competitiveness
 - Or that increase energy and environmental performance of their processes or their products
- It was funded with 500 million €, when launched in July 2010
- Further 340 million € are made available for the period 2014-2017 to allow low interest loans to finance smes investment in all industrial sectors.
- It is managed by BPI-France : French Public Bank for Investment :
 - Loans from 100 000 € to 3 000 000 €
 - Length of 7 years
 - with a 2-year grace period in capital
 - High EE equipment can be financed : efficient boilers, energy monitoring systems...

“Eco-Energy loans”



- These soft loans are also managed by BPI-France since March 2012
- State funding of 33 million €, to distribute and guarantee loans of up to 100 million €.
- Scheme designed for smes, to help them increase their EE
- Four categories of EE equipment can be financed through these loans :
 - EE lighting systems
 - Heating (for example : heat pumps)
 - Air-conditioning
 - Electric motorisation : efficient motors
- Loans between 10 000 € and 50 000 €, for a duration of 5 years, with a 1-year grace period in capital, a fixed low interest rate of 2%. No guarantee or individual caution are requested.
